The International Federation of Landscape Architects (IFLA) is hosting its 61th World Council and Congress between 8th and 13th September in Nantes, France. This comprises of the IFLA World Council 10th - 12th, The World Congress 8th -11th and Post-Congress Tour on 13th.

Founded in 1948, the International Federation of Landscape Architects (IFLA) is the only international non-governmental organisation representing landscape architects worldwide, embodying 78 national members and more than 50,000 landscape architects worldwide. IFLA's mission is to promote the landscape architecture profession within a collaborative partnership of the allied built-environment professions, demanding the highest standards of education, training, research and professional practice and providing leadership and stewardship in all matters.

IFLA is governed by a World Council, which comprises officers of the Executive Committee and the duly appointed delegates of the national or multi-national associations admitted to IFLA as Category A members. According to our constitution, Category A memberships are awarded to national and multi-national associations of landscape architects defined by country, countries or territories whose constitutions and by-laws have been approved by the World Council. Only one representative association per country or territory/s is permitted, with the right to vote (one vote per Category A member) at the IFLA World Council.

We look forward to welcoming you to Nantes in September.
